

What is ANYTOWN?

Camp ANYTOWN is a nationally recognized and award winning diversity, leadership, and social justice program for youth ages 14-18. Founded in 1957, ANYTOWN is designed to educate, liberate, and empower youth participants (delegates) to become effective, responsible leaders and community builders. For six days, a diverse group of 60 high school students come together to build a community based on respect, understanding, and inclusivity.

Through fun and engaging workshops, Delegates along with 25 staff members explore the thoughts, opinions and experiences we all share on topics like bias, bigotry, oppression, and social change. Through this dialogue, the Delegates are taken on an inspiring journey to create a model for an ideal community in which members move beyond tolerating each others differences to celebrating them. It is the goal of ANYTOWN to equip young leaders with the knowledge and skills to transform their home communities into places where individual differences are seen as positive tools that bring people together instead of keeping them apart.



Where is ANYTOWN?

ANYTOWN is located on the beautiful camp site of Camp Becket-Chimney Corners in Becket, Massachusetts. On over 1400 acres of woodland in Berkshires of Massachusetts, ANYTOWN delegates come to build a community that is free of bias and bigotry. Delegates are housed in same-gender cabins staffed by two counselors.

- Improve leadership, communication, peace-building, and conflict resolution skills.
- Enhance trust, respect, and understanding of diverse peoples and experiences.
- Learn about social justice and how to make change in their schools and communities.
- Be listened to and more importantly, be *heard*.
- Make **true** friends in a short time.

Who Should Apply?

- Youth age 14 to 18 currently living in Connecticut or Western Massachusetts.
- Youth who are leaders in their schools or want to know how to become a leader.
- Youth who want to work to create an inclusive, just, and accepting community.
- Youth who are interested in exploring their own social identities and biases
- Youth interested in developing skills in activism and leadership.

How much does it Cost?
